BREAK IN REPORT – AUGUST 2017

On 2/8/17 at 01:29 hrs an alarm signal was received from the Avenues. Intruders gained entry by cutting three burglar bars and forced open a door to enter into one of the classrooms. Nothing was stolen as the **intruders ran away when the alarm sounded.**

On 10/8/17 a client phoned in from Vainona to report a break in where intruders stole her gate motor which **was not covered by the alarm system.** Property has a durawall and burglar bars.

On 13/8/17 at 13:13 hrs a call was received from Mount Pleasant requesting reaction team as there was a break-in the night before. Intruders gained entry by removing three bottom panels of a durawall and crawled into the yard where they stole water taps and hosepipes. The intruders **entered whilst the alarm was not armed.** The property has a durawall and burglar bars.

On 14/8/17 at 00:11 hrs an alarm signal was received from Milton Park. Intruders gained entry by smashing one of the windows with a stone, the windows were not protected by burglar bars and made entry into the offices. Nothing was stolen as the **intruders ran away when the alarm sounded.**

On 14/8/17 at 11:42 hrs an alarm signal was received from Cotsworld Hill. Intruders gained entry by cutting four strands of electric fence and jumped inside the yard where they broke the fuel pipe from underneath a car and drained diesel and ran away. Property has a durawall and electric fence.

On 14/8/17 at 22:28 hrs an alarm signal was received from a Base Station in Dzivarasekwa. Intruders gained entry by breaking palisade fence bars. They stole a generator battery and ran away.

On 22/8/17 at 02:56 hrs a panic signal was received from Mount Pleasant. Intruders gained entry by jumping over the durawall. On hearing some noises in the yard, the client **pressed the panic button, the alarm triggered,** which prompted the intruders to run away.

On 23/8/17 our client from Mabelreign phoned in to report a break in where intruders gained entry by removing a panel from the durawall and tried to force open the door and window with no luck. Intruders stole water taps. **The alarm did not sound as this area was not covered by the alarm system.**

On 28/8/17 at 0208 hrs an alarm signal was received from the Grange. Intruders gained entry by cutting the razor wire and jumping over the durawall. They attempted to steal the borehole pump but **fled empty handed when the alarm sounded.**

On 29/8/17 at 03:46hrs an alarm signal was received from Greendale. Intruders gained entry by jumping over the durawall. They tried to steal the gate motor but ran away **when the alarm sounded.**

On 31/8/17 at 0054 hrs an alarm signal was received from the City Centre. Intruders gained entry by cutting the razor wire and jumping over the wall but **ran away when the alarm sounded.**

MIDLANDS PROVINCE

On 25/08/2017, an unknown number of thieves gained access on a property at Harben park in Gweru and stole chickens from the chicken coop. The chicken coop is situated about 60 paces away from the main house that is alarmed. The occupants were alerted by the barking dog, but the chickens had already been stolen. **The area where the chicken coop is situated is not covered with beams.**

On 25/08/2017, in the low density of Nothlea in Gweru, intruders scaled the perimeter durawall and attempted to access the main house, **but were picked up by alarm sensors and absconded empty handed.**

On the 30/08/2017, intruders attempted to steal from a shop in the CBD of Gweru and in the process the **alarm system triggered and the intruders ran away.**

BULAWAYO

On 4/8/17 at approximately 08:00hrs we were advised that a Liquor wholesale in the Renkini area had been broken into. No signal was received as the intruders gained entry by breaking the roofing asbestos, walked on roofing trusses away from an alarm sensor coverage, and hooked off the alarm connections, i.e battery, control panel and radio link. They descended onto the floor to conduct searches in various offices, undetected by the alarm which was now dysfunctional. Management advised that only \$40.00 could have been stolen. Alarm was installed by a private installer and we recommended that the Control panel, Radio link and battery which are in full view of the public, to be moved to a hidden place in one of the offices.

On 10/8/17 at approximately 08:30hrs a Manager of motor industry premises, called to advise that there was a break in. No signal was received as thieves broke a display window with a stone. They were dummy batteries by the window. The thieves probably realised that the batteries on display were dummies and abandoned further criminal acts.

On 24/8/19 at a busy beer wholeseller was broken into through the roof. **An alarm signal was received and reaction quickly reacted disturbing the intruders** who then ran away.

MUTARE

On 15/08/2017 at 07:23 hrs in the Murambi area a panic signal was received by our control room. The response team was dispatched and on arrival they were advised by the client that there was a break-in at the premises the previous night and money and some jewellery were stolen. **Investigation revealed that the alarm was not armed when the break in occurred.**

On the 28/08/2017 at 03:20 hrs in Murambi area we received a phone call from one of our clients requesting response team. Response team was dispatched and on arrival were advised that there were intruders in the premises. Property valued at \$300, 00 was said to have been stolen. **The intruders broke into the cottage which is not protected with an alarm system.**
