BREAK IN REPORT JANUARY 2016

On 02/01/16 at 1019hrs in Alexandra Park, intruders cut razor wire and jumped over the durawall and gained entry into the yard, they stole various items and went away. The alarm did not trigger because the system was not armed. Property has a durawall, razor wire and electric gate.

On 04/01/16 at 1047hrs in Houghton Park, intruders cut one palisade fence bar and gained entry in the base station, they broke the lock to the fuel tank and started siphoning fuel, **the alarm triggered and they ran away leaving the containers behind.**

On 04/01/16 at 0403hrs in Mt Hampden, intruders cut 5 strands of electric wire and jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, stole a tarpaulin covering bags of fertilizer and went away. The guard pressed his panic button when he noticed they had already gone. Property has electric fence, durawall and electric gate.

On 12/01/16 at 0900hrs in Willowvale, intruders cut palisade fence bar and gained entry to a base station, tried to siphon fuel from the generator, **the alarm triggered and they ran away.** Property has palisade.

On 22/01/16 at 0345hrs in Avondale, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, broke one of the office windows, **the alarm triggered and they ran away.** Property has a durawall and manual gate.

On 22/01/16 at 2324hrs in Zimre Park, intruders twisted one iron bar and entered a base station, they connected a hose pipe to drain fuel from a generator, **the alarm triggered and they ran away leaving behind the hose pipes, spanner and the containers**. Property has palisade fence.

On 25/01/16 at 1047hrs in Arcadia, intruders broke palisade bars and gained entry in a base station, <u>alarm</u> triggered and they ran away. Property has palisade.

MUTARE

On the 31/12/2015 in the city centre at 15:49 hours the alarm activated at one of our client's properties. Response team was sent and on arrival they noted that a door at a cottage was broken. The key holder was informed and attended. He advised that nothing was stolen. <u>It is suspected that on hearing the alarm sounding the intruders ran away.</u>

On the -2/01/2016 in the Murambi area at 08:38 hours an alarm activated at a client premises and response team was dispatched. On arrival the team met a client who advised that there was a break in and theft the previous night. The client also advised that the alarm was not armed when the break in occurred.

On the 03/01/2016 in the city area a client phoned our control room at 19:42 hours reporting that there was a break in at his premises. Our response team attended and met the client who showed them a mentally challenged man whom he claims broke the glass of his door. The alarm did not send any signal at our control room. On checking we noted that the alarm was not armed when the incident occurred.

On the 10/01/2016 in the city centre an alarm activated at a client property response team was dispatched and could not see any sign of break in. The client was phoned and was not reachable. The following morning the client phoned and reported that there was a break in and theft. The intruders gained access into the building through the roof. Whilst inside they damaged all the sensors.

On the 10/01/2016 in the Greenside area a client phoned reporting that they was a break in at her premises. Our supervisors attended and noted that a spare bedroom window was damaged. **The alarm sounded at the premises and intruders ran away.** It was established that the system's battery was faulty and was not holding enough power to enable signals to be sent to our control room.

On 22/01/2016 in the city centre an alarm activated and response team attended. They established that the office windows were broken. <u>It is suspected that on hearing the alarm</u> sounding the intruders ran away.
