BREAK IN REPORT SEPTEMBER 2016

On 04/09/16 at 03:47hrs in Avenues, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, went to the house and broke a window, the alarm triggered and they ran away. Property has durawall, electric gate and burglar bars.

On 04/09/16 at 0022hrs in Town, intruders broke main glass door, the alarm triggered and they ran away. Property has screen gates and burglar bars.

On 09/09/16 at 1330hrs in Gunhill, intruders jumped over the durawall and entered the yard, they broke the kitchen door, the alarm triggered and they ran away. Property has, durawall, electric gate, burglar bars.

On 09/09/16 at 0945hrs in Town, intruders broke a sliding door and entered the shop. They stole some items and went away. The alarm did not trigger because it was not armed. Property has burglar bars on windows.

On 19/09/16 at 0149hrs in Goromonzi, intruders broke the shop window and managed to get inside, they stole a cash box, the alarm triggered and they ran away with the box. Property has burglar bars.

MIDLANDS PROVINCE

On 26/09/2016, at a paint shop in the CBD intruders broke into the and stole cash. The shop had an alarm which sounded and a response team attended, but could not detect the intruders who were already inside the building after gaining entry through the roof.

On the night of 30/09/16, intruders scaled the durawall securing property to a house in the low density suburb of Northlea and tried to steal a spare wheel from a parked vehicle. The alarm sounded and the intruders ran away.

BULAWAYO

On 31/8/16 in the CBD intruders broke into a gift shop through the skylight of the building and vandalised the sensors which was covered by goods. They proceeded to the laptops and cell phones section where they stole laptops and cell phones. **There was no reaction because the alarm did not activate due to the fact that the intruders vandalised the sensors.** The shop is secured by screened doors and razor wire on the roof which is not high enough.

On 11/9/16 at a time not known in the CBD, intruders broke into a Gaming building through a toilet window and proceeded to the supervisor's office where they blew the safe and stole money. **The alarm did not activate because there the sensors covering the area were painted over during renovations and did not pick the motion. There was also a new partition which blocked the other sensor at the back.** The windows at the back were flimsily screened and there was no adequate sensor coverage.

On 18/9/2016 there was an attempted break in, in the CBD when intruders tried to remove one corrugated zinc sheet by removing the nails. **The alarm activated and the reaction team attended but the intruders had fled before the arrival of the response crew.** Nothing was stolen. The premise has screened doors and windows at the front and alarm coverage inside.

On 20/9/2016 intruders broke into a truck workshop in Belmont through the roof and stole a diagnostic computer, laptop, a TV and HIFI set. They also tried to blow the safe but failed. **The alarm system was vandalized and there was no activation.** There is also no adequate sensor coverage. The place has screened outside doors and a security fence.

MUTARE

On the 8/9/2016 in the Greenside area an alarm activated at a client's residence. Response was dispatched on arrival they discovered that the intruders had made a hole in the fence. Nothing was reported stolen. The alarm was sounded after the client had noticed the breaking.

On the 10/09/2016 in Murambi area an alarm activated and response was dispatched. On arrival they discovered that one of the cottages was broken into. **The cottage is not protected by an alarm system.** The client had activated the alarm on hearing the intruders breaking into the cottage.
