# BREAK IN REPORT - JULY 2018

On 7/7/18 at 09:01 hours our client from the city centre called to advise us of a break in the night before. Intruders gained entry through the main warehouse after creating an opening on one of the zinc roof sheets of the shop. They stole some computer accessories and when away. <u>The alarm did not activate as it was not armed.</u>

On 12/7/18 at 10:20 hours our client from Highlands called advising us of a break in the night before. Intruders forced open a window and stole a laptop. This area is not covered by an alarm.

On 16/7/18 our client from kambanji called advising us of a break in the night before. Intruders cut 5 strands of electric fence and jumped inside the property. They broke the lock for the gate motor **but escaped when the alarm sounded**.

On 24/7/18 at 01:13 hours an alarm signal was received from Southerton. Intruders gained entry by jumping over an unprotected durawall and cut the mesh wire leading to the storeroom and stole some goods. This area is not covered by an alarm.

On 24/7/18 at 11:00 hours our client from the city centre called in to advise of a break in the night before. Intruders gained entry by breaking a window at the back of the shop, removed the louvers and stole 8 suits. This area was not covered by an alarm.

On 26/7/18 at 02:02 hours an alarm signal was received from the city centre. Intruders made a small hole in the **window but fled empty handed when the alarm sounded.** 

### **MIDLANDS PROVINCE**

### <u>Masvingo</u>

On 06/07/2018 at 0055 hrs an alarm signal was received from Rhodene Suburb, intruders cut razor wire and jumped over the durawall, they forced open a window, entered the house, the alarm triggered and they ran away. The Reaction team attended swiftly and upon checking the premises with the owner of the house, they found out that nothing had been stolen.

## **BULAWAYO**

On 11/7/18 at 2116hrs an alarm activated from a Golf Club in town. On arrival, the response team found that intruders broke a window and accessed the bar from an area not protected by the alarm sensor or burglar bar. They quickly stole some whiskey and other beverages and the alarm sensors in another area of the club activated as they were exiting the property. A quotation has been given to extend the alarm to the area and the value of stolen property is \$ 464.20.

On 11/7/18 in the early morning hours intruders jumped over the durawall of a residential property and attempted to break in through the kitchen window but were scared off by vicious dogs on site. No alarm activated because the premises only have inside alarm sensors. Nothing was stolen.

### **MUTARE**

On 16/7/2018 at 0227 hrs a panic signal was received from the Industrial area. A response was dispatched. On arrival they were shown a customer who had stolen client's property and was resisting arrest. The response team assisted in apprehending the accused and handed him over to Mutare Central Police.
